Portugal claimed the land of Brazil in the year 1500.

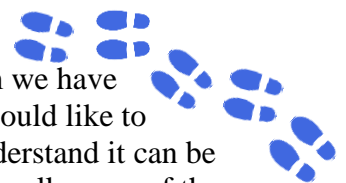


### Sorry No Dogs

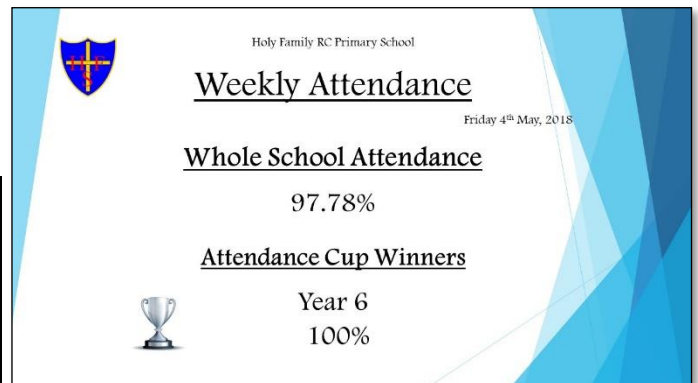
## Online Payments
