The tiny Dart Frog which is native to the Rainforests of South America is only around 1 inch in size but has enough poison to kill 10 grown men. Beware!





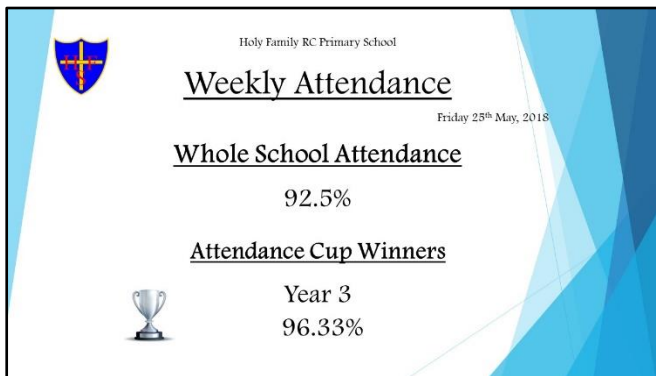
