Please find below a list of recommended equipment for a trip to the beach in the Summer term. The children **do not have to wear school uniform**, please see below for details of what they should wear.

Clothing:

Jogging bottoms or leggings (no jeans as they are bad conductors of heat.)
Vest, Tee shirt, Sweat shirt/fleece/jumper.
Waterproof jacket
Trainers or wellingtons
Cap/hat
Sun tan lotion

Equipment in a back pack:

Packed lunch to include fruit
Two drinks
Spare clothing - socks, pants, shorts/joggers, tee shirt, long sleeved top
Small towel
Sun tan lotion
Plastic bag to sit on and then to be used to bring wet clothes home.

It is strongly recommended that children have four layers of clothing on their upper body, so that all eventualities are covered. The temperature on the beach can be deceptively chilly, when the wind is blowing.
