In Year 1 this week they received a special parcel from the Man on the Moon. They are all really excited to find out more about him and are hoping for another parcel soon.

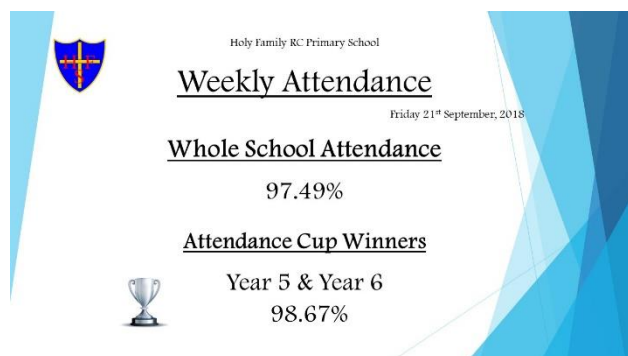
